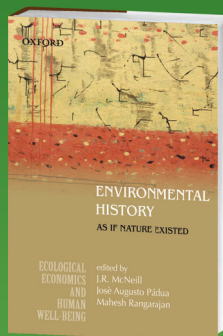

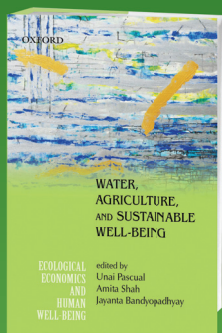
## Environmental History

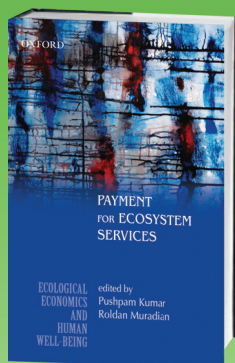


## Science for Policy

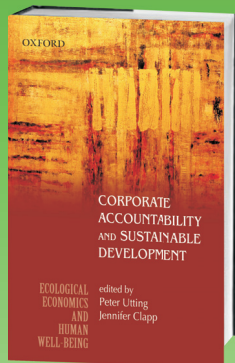


## Payment for Ecosystem Services

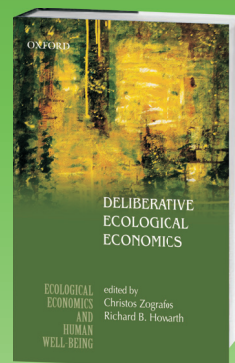


## Corporate Accountability and Sustainable Development
